
The Brothers of Mercy Wellness Campus impact spans decades and generations

For more than a century, The Brothers of Mercy has been part of our community, providing Western New Yorkers with a variety of compassionate health care services. This legacy started when six Brothers arrived from Germany in 1924 to begin their mission of caring for people in Buffalo. They rode bicycles around the city to provide inhome nursing care for the sick and elderly and made more than 76,000 house calls in their first 25 years. The Brothers of Mercy relocated from Buffalo to Clarence in 1950 and built their first senior care home. Sacred Heart Home, in 1952.

Over the next several decades, the nonprofit organization expanded to become The Brothers of Mercy Wellness Campus, which is now comprised of six facilities that provide comprehensive residential, health care and rehabilitation services. The Brothers' humble mission – to honor Christ through service to others – is the foundation upon which the campus was built and has grown, touching countless lives and spanning generations.

The organization operates a 5-star, Medicare-rated 126-acre campus at Ransom and Bergtold roads in Clarence. With a continuum of lifestyle options, The Brothers of Mercy ministry of care features skilled nursing, palliative care, hospice, inpatient and outpatient therapies, assisted living and memory care, independent living and spiritual care. It is the largest retirement community in the region, as ranked by Buffalo Business First, and ranks annually on the U.S. News & World Report and Newsweek's "America's Best Nursing Homes" lists.









The organization would like the community to know it is proud to continue its legacy of providing high-quality, compassionate, continuing care for Western New Yorkers who come for rehabilitation services or to live on the Wellness Campus. They are committed to continuing the healing mission as inspired by their founder, Brother Ignatius Loetschert, and of the Catholic Church through a ministry of service.
